



4-H Agriculture Scholarship

The Grant County 4-H Council, in collaboration with the company formerly known as Bi-County, will be sponsoring \$1,000.00+ scholarships for Grant County 4-H participants who plan to continue their education in agriculture or a related field of study. This opportunity is open to any **current** or **former** individual who was previously or is currently involved in 4-H and plans to continue their education in agriculture or a related field of study. The program must be designated as an agriculture related degree or certification by the institution they are attending. This is an opportunity to allow Grant County 4-H to assist a 4-Her that is continuing their education and help make a difference in their life.

The recipient will receive the scholarship after their first semester and must maintain a 2.5 GPA or above. At the conclusion of the first semester, the recipient must submit a copy of their grades to the 4-H Council. Once the recipient submits these and they are approved, the scholarship check will be mailed directly to the financial department of the recipient's institution.

Application requirements for the scholarship are listed below and a copy of the application is attached. Only applicants meeting **ALL** the requirements will be considered.

Requirements:

(Highlighted bullets require something to be submitted with the completed application)

- Must be a current senior graduating high school in 2024 up to 25 years old. (Ages 17-25)
- Must have been an active 4-H member for a minimum of 2 consecutive years.
- Must have an average GPA of 2.5 or higher at the time of applying and maintain a GPA of 2.5 or higher until the scholarship is fulfilled.
- Must be studying or plan to study at a post-secondary institution.
- Must have a passion for food agriculture/ natural resources.
- Must be pursuing a degree or certificate in agriculture or related field of study.
- **Must submit a copy of your transcript(s).**
- **Must provide a School Acceptance Letter (High School Seniors Only)**
- **Must write a 200-word essay about your goals after the completion of your degree or certificate.** (Can write in space provided or type and attach)
- **Must submit 2 letters of recommendation**, one being someone from 4-H (excluding the 4-H Agent) and one from another member of the community (that is a non-relative).

APPLICATIONS ARE DUE BACK TO THE GRANT COUNTY EXTENSION OFFICE BY APRIL 1st.

After the deadline, applicant interviews will be scheduled with the 4-H agent and a 4-H council member.
