

## **Grant County 4-H Council Scholarship**

The Grant County 4-H Council will be sponsoring a scholarship of \$1,000 for a Grant County 4-H participant who plans on attending college. This is an opportunity to allow Grant County 4-H to assist a 4-Her that is continuing their education and help make a difference in their life.

The recipient will receive the scholarship <u>after their first semester</u> and <u>must maintain a 2.5 GPA</u> or above. At the conclusion of the semester, the <u>recipient will submit a copy of their grades to the 4-H Council</u>. Once the recipient submits these and they are approved, <u>the scholarship check will be mailed directly to the financial department of the recipient's institution</u>.

Application requirements for the scholarship are listed below and a copy of the application is attached. Only applicants with **ALL** requirements will be considered.

## Requirements

(Highlighted bullets require something to be submitted with the completed application)

- Must be studying or plan to study at a post-secondary institution.
- Must have been active in 4-H for a minimum of 2 consecutive years.
- Must be a current undergraduate student or senior graduating high school in 2024.
- Must have an average GPA of 2.5 or higher at the time of applying and maintain a GPA of 2.5 until the scholarship is fulfilled.
- Must provide a list of 4-H achievements or projects.
- Must submit a copy of your transcript(s).
- Must provide a School Acceptance Letter (High School Seniors Only).
- Must write a 200-word essay addressing one of the following prompts:
  - What has 4-H done for you?
  - How has 4-H changed your life?
  - How will you take what you have learned in 4-H to guide you in your life?
    (Can write in provided space or type and attach)
- Must submit 2 letters of recommendation, one being someone from 4-H (excluding the 4-H Agent) and one from another member of the community (that is a non-relative).

## APPLICATIONS ARE DUE BACK TO THE GRANT COUNTY EXTENSION OFFICE BY APRIL 1st.

After the deadline, applicant interviews will be scheduled with the 4-H agent and a 4-H council member.

(No late applications will be considered)
