

2025 Grant County 4-H Council Scholarship

The Grant County 4-H Council will be sponsoring a scholarship of \$1,500 for a Grant County 4-H participant who plans on attending college, or any other post-secondary educational institution. This is an opportunity to allow Grant County 4-H to assist a 4-Her that is continuing their education and help make a difference in their life.

The recipient will receive the scholarship <u>after their first semester</u> and <u>must maintain a</u> 3.0 GPA or above. At the conclusion of the semester, <u>the recipient will submit a copy of their grades to the 4-H Council</u>. Once the recipient submits these and they are approved, <u>the scholarship check will be mailed directly to the financial department of the recipient's institution</u>.

Application requirements for the scholarship are listed below and a copy of the application is attached. Only applicants with ALL requirements will be considered.

Requirements

(Highlighted bullets require something to be submitted with the completed application)

- Must be studying or plan to study at a post-secondary institution.
 - Must have be an active 4-H member for a minimum of 2 consecutive years. (Must have been involved in at least one of the following clubs or activities for the past 2 years: Livestock, Country Ham, Cooking, Sewing, Shooting Sports, Horse, Dog, Horticulture, Photography, Teen Council, RC Club, 4-H Camp Junior Counselor.)
- Must be a senior graduating high school in 2025.
- Must have an average GPA of 3.0 or higher at the time of applying and maintain a GPA of 3.0 until the scholarship is fulfilled.
- Must provide a list of 4-H achievements or projects.
- Must submit a copy of your High School transcript(s).
- Must provide a School Acceptance Letter.
- Must write a 200-word essay addressing one of the following prompts:
 - What has 4-H done for you? How has 4-H changed your life? How will you take what you have learned in 4-H to guide you in your life? (Please type and attach essay)
- Must submit 2 letters of recommendation, one being someone from 4-H (excluding the 4-H Agent) and one from another member of the community (that is a non-relative).
 APPLICATIONS ARE DUE BACK TO THE GRANT COUNTY EXTENSION OFFICE BY APRIL 20th, 2025.
